



A Field Trip on Integrated Fuel Treatments

June 13 & 14, 2013 • Priest River Experimental Forest, Idaho

The Northern Rockies Fire Science Network and the USFS Rocky Mountain Research Station invite managers and scientists to an integrated fuel treatment field trip at the Priest River Experimental Forest in North Idaho. The field trip will focus on multidisciplinary research to help develop and evaluate alternative restoration/fuel treatments that are ecologically sound, socially acceptable, and economically viable. Scientists and managers will discuss these approaches and determine how they may meet some of the challenges managers face.
